Give each child a Numeral Necklace (card with a numeral from 1-9 and yarn for hanging around neck). Instruct children to do the action associated with the numeral on their necklace. After singing the song a few times, invite children to create and their own movements.

spin and slide across the floor.



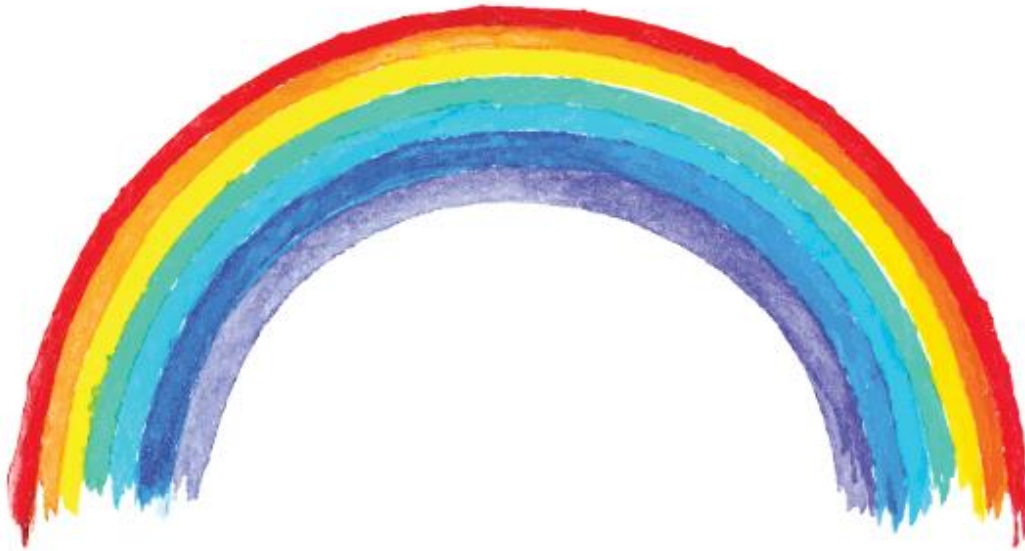
Let's all shimmy. Let's all soar.

Give each child a red, yellow, orange, green, blue or purple streamer. Invite children to do the action associated with the color of their streamer. After singing the song a few times, invite children to create their own movements.
